Principal Update-Anne Erwin

Week of Wishes is next week. Also, on Thursday, Feb. 19th, it is Freshmen Family night. The school will be feeding families and there are activities as well as classroom visits scheduled. Should be a fun night. Recent report about graduation rate is not good for BHS. Graduation rate can be raised, but it is a four-year story. 5% more 5th year students graduated last year than previously. BHS is focusing on what can be changed over the next four years. One of the programs to help is 'Beaver Achievers', currently open to 9th grade and soon to be open to 10th grade. It provides an opportunity for struggling students to receive help from peer mentors. Peer tutors are assigned to 9th grade to help with math during Beaver Lodge. Another program to provide help is Parent Success Seminars by counselor. The program will focus on students with F's and D's to help families help students be successful. Any solutions need to be able to reach all students. Economically challenged students have a graduation rate of approximately 58% and ELL students approximately 30%. The goal is to apply support equally across the entire school and lift ALL levels of student higher. Positives from this year's first semester...decrease in the number of failed classes and 415 students had perfect attendance.

Success Fund Update-Anne Erwin and Scott Reames

\$40,000 pledged at this point, but no in hand yet. For the 3 year plan, we have passed the ½ million mark.

Funds Requests

There are no funds requests this month. The ice machine is to be replaced by the school. Donations to help off set the cost can be made through the Booster Club website.

Treasurers Update-Laura Vartanian

There is \$3,000 more to be added to the concessions figures. The numbers look good. The committee is in place for the scholarships, they will be sending out communications soon.
